Nursing Facilities

- Development of a program to support “Behaviorally Complex Individuals”
- Working with Managed Care
- Collaboration with Division of Welfare and Supportive Services



Community Based Providers

- Merge of Assisted Living and Frail/Elderly Waiver
- Adult Day Health Care
 - Per Diem Billing
- New Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Regulations as of March 2014
 - Provide opportunities to seek employment and work in competitive integrated settings, engage in community life, and control personal resources



Personal Care Services

- New Functional Assessment
- Streamlined Enrollment Process
- Consolidated Review Process
- ISO Certification



Issues to Consider

- Department of Labor
 - Fair Labor Standards Act
- Access to Care
 - High number of people trying to access a finite number of providers
- Retention of Providers
 - Rates
 - Billing/Reimbursement
 - New Regulations
- Current Infrastructure of Nevada
 - Inability to care for recipients in-state
