A hysterectomy is the removal of the whole uterus (womb). A hysterectomy cannot be undone and it will permanently prevent you from having children.

A hysterectomy should only be done when there is a disease of the woman's uterus (womb) or some other problem that can only be treated by removing the uterus (womb). It is a serious operation and there are discomforts and a chance of serious health problems.

A hysterectomy is not eligible for payment from Medicaid if the reason you had it was to avoid bearing children.
