Benefits of ICD-10



Benefits of ICD-10

- Expands flexibility to update the codes as needed
- Provides greater clinical detail and specificity
- Enhances coding accuracy and improves claims payment accuracy and efficiency
- Improves case management and care coordination



Benefits of ICD-10

- Enhances the prevention and detection of fraud, waste and abuse
- Terminology and disease classifications have been updated to be consistent with current clinical practice
- Enhanced ability to track and monitor the spread of disease

Health Care Industry Impacts

All facets of the health care industry will be affected by ICD-10:

- Health care payers and clearinghouses
- Providers and patients
- Employers' and workers' compensation plans
- Insurance brokers and auto insurers



Health Care Industry Impacts

- Changes in the way coverage for services is determined
- Changes in the way services are reimbursed
- More time needed for providers to determine which ICD-10 codes to use



Health Care Industry Impacts

- Database systems and computer software upgrades
- Training required for nearly everyone who uses or has contact with ICD-10
- Increased claim rejections, denials and pending claims due to non-compliance with ICD-10

ICD-9	ICD-10-CM
3 to 5 numeric digits	3 to 7 alphanumeric digits
13,000 codes	68,000 codes

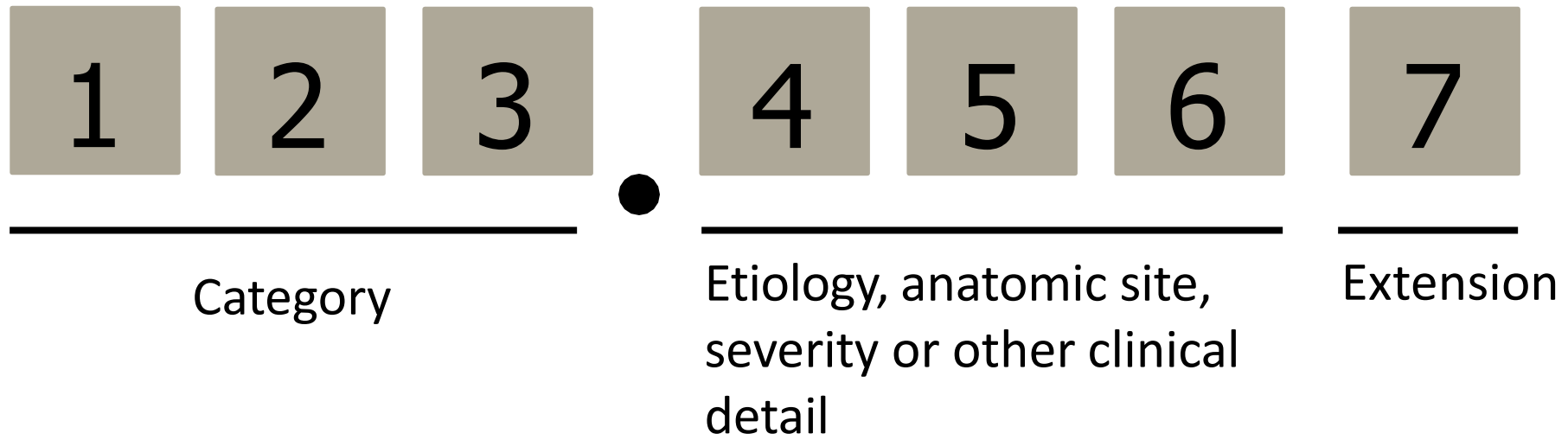
ICD-9-CM

- **Forearm Fracture**
 - 813.40
 - Closed fracture of lower end of forearm, unspecified

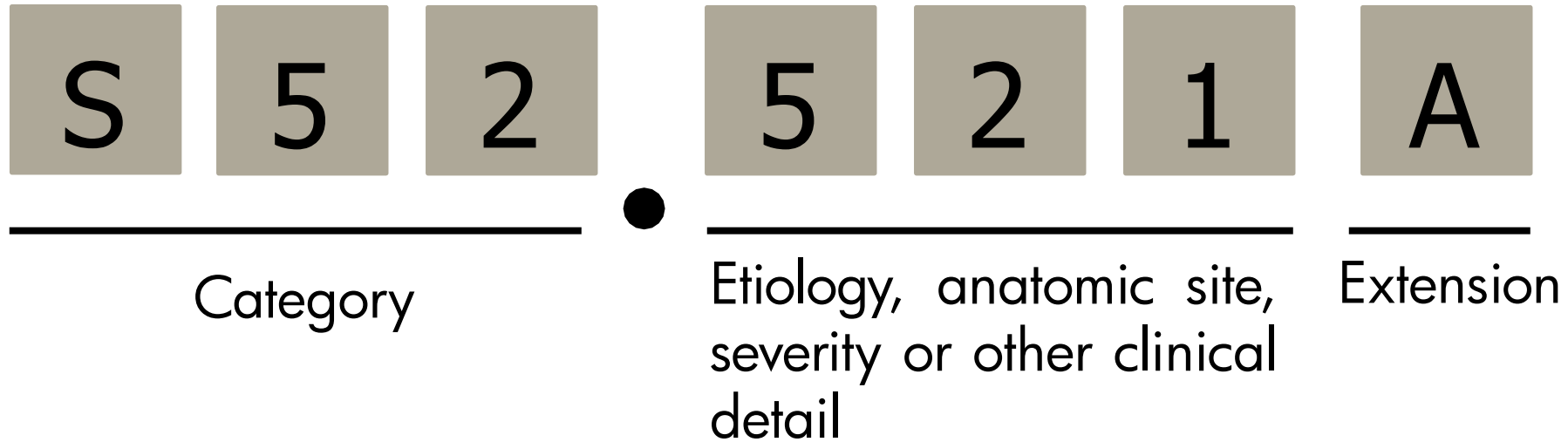
ICD-10-CM

- **Forearm Fracture**
 - S52.521A
 - Torus fracture of lower end of right radius, initial encounter for closed fracture

Specificity of Forearm Fracture

S52 - Fracture of forearm

S52.5 - Fracture of lower end of radius

S52.52 - Torus fracture of lower end of radius

S52.521 - Torus fracture of lower end of right radius

Procedure Coding System Comparison

ICD-9	ICD-10-PCS
3 to 5 numeric digits	7 alphanumeric digits
3,000 codes	87,000 codes

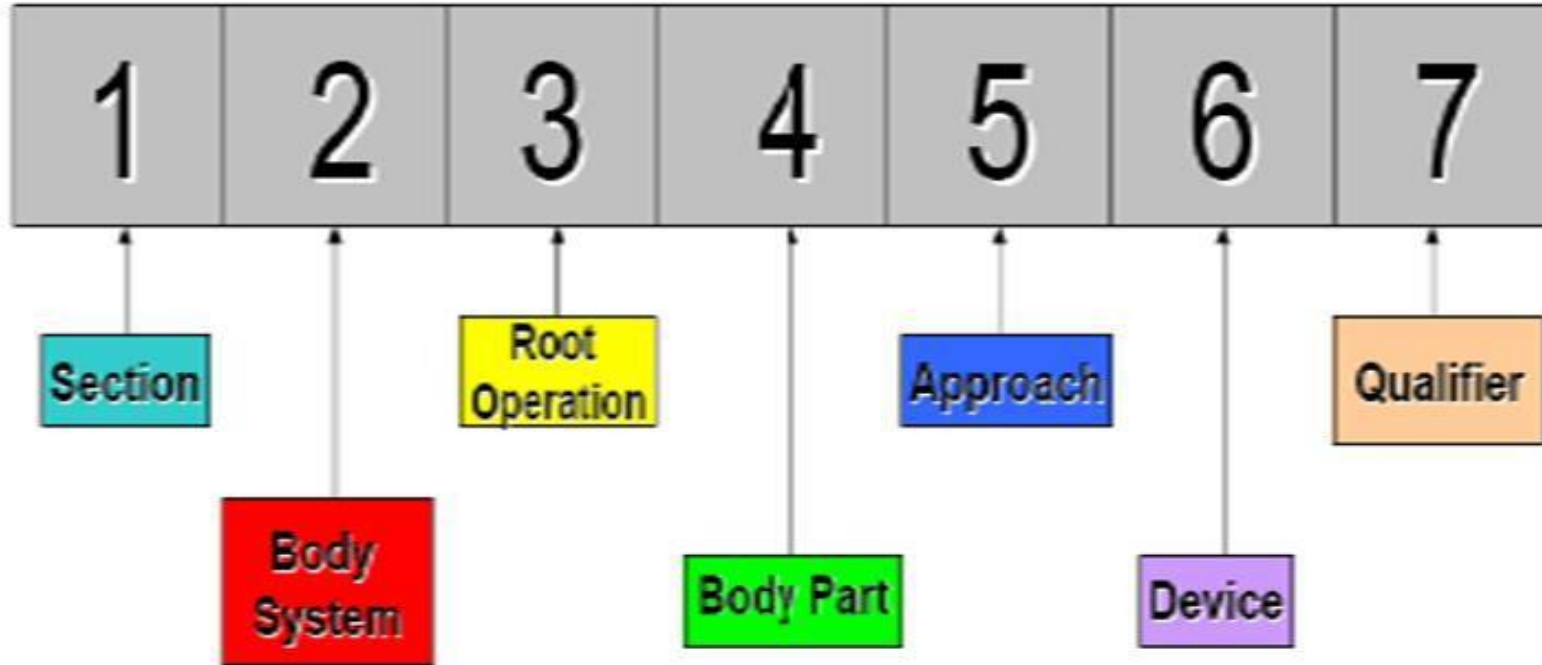

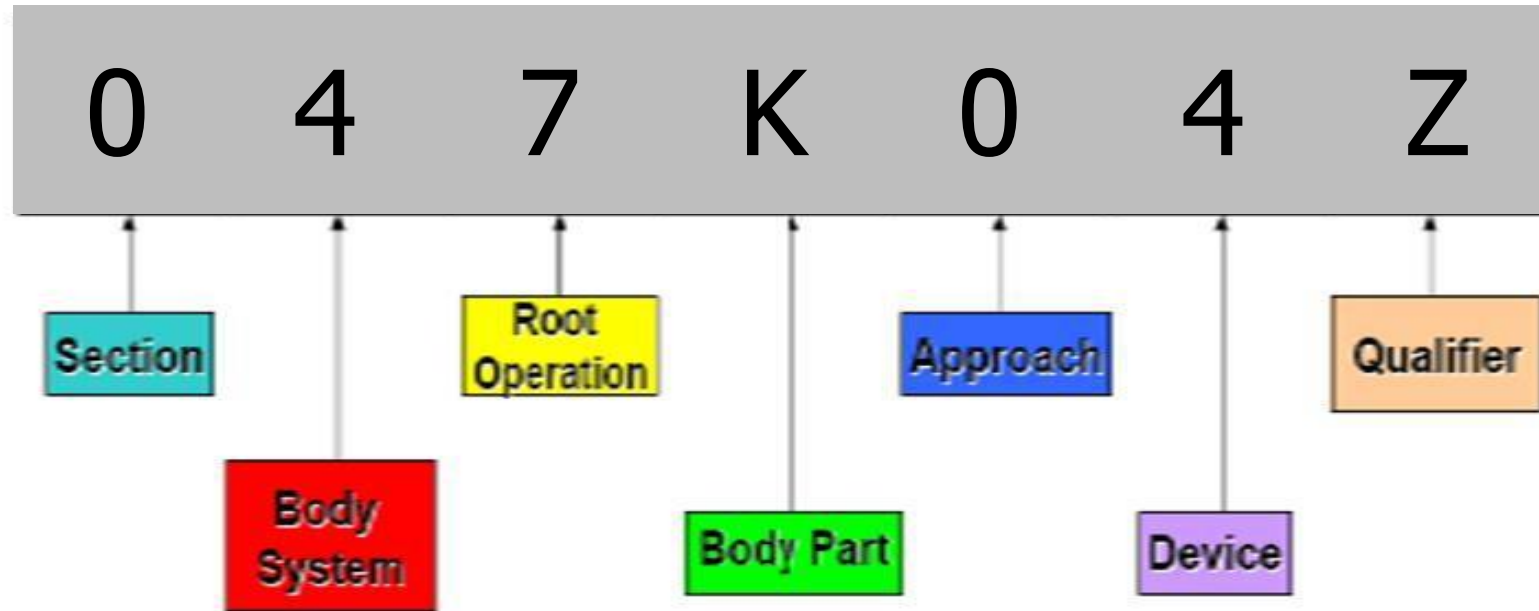

Breakdown of Angioplasty PCS Code

047K04Z

0 = Medical and surgical section

4 = Lower arteries

7 = Dilation

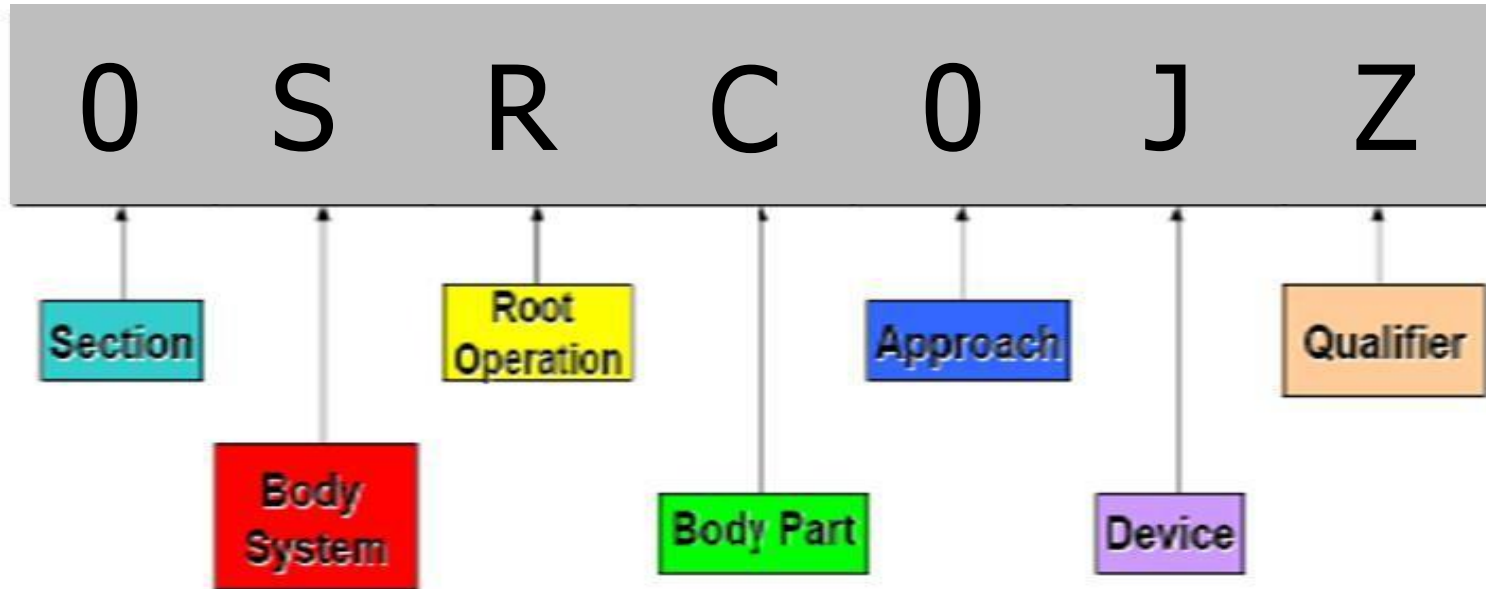
K = Femoral artery, right

0 = Open

4 = Intraluminal device, drug-eluting

Z = No qualifier

ICD-10-PCS: Knee Replacement



OSRC0JZ: Replacement of the right knee with synthetic substitute, open approach



Breakdown of Knee Replacement Code

0SRC0JZ

0 = Medical and surgical section

S = Lower joints

R = Replacement

C = Knee joint, right

0 = Open

J = Synthetic substitute

Z = No qualifier


