

Nevada Medicaid Pharmacy Billing Instructions for Medicare Part D/Medicaid Dual Eligible Recipients

All claims for dual eligible recipients (recipients eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare Part D) must be billed to the recipient's Medicare Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) prior to billing Nevada Medicaid. Submit the claim to Medicaid using standard Third Party Liability (TPL) processing. Include all required Coordination of Benefits (COB) processing fields.

Nevada Medicaid claims for Part D dual eligible recipients must include:

- PROCESSOR CONTROL NUMBER (NCPDP Field 104-A4) of "P031009646."
- OTHER PAYER ID (NCPDP Field 340-7C) of "07450."

Medicare-Excluded Drugs

When the PDP denies the claim as a non-covered benefit, NCPDP Field 308-C8 ("Other Coverage Code") must contain a "3" (Other coverage exists, this claim not covered). All current Medicaid limitations and exclusions apply to claims not covered by a recipient's PDP.

Nevada Medicaid will continue to pay for the following types of drugs that (in most cases) will not be covered by the PDP. Both Rx and over the counter (OTC) claims require a prescription.

- OTC Medications
- Cough and Cold Medicines
- Vitamin and Mineral Supplements including Prenatal Vitamins
- Barbiturates
- Benzodiazepines
