## Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee Makes Changes to Preferred Drug List

On September 28, 2017, the Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) committee of the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services' Division of Health Care Financing and Policy met to review new and existing therapeutic drug classes on the Nevada Medicaid Preferred Drug List (PDL).
