Pharmacy Announcement

Vaccines Administered by Pharmacies

On April 17, 2012, Nevada Medicaid allowed pharmacies to bill for vaccines administered by a pharmacist. Claims for recipients 18 years old and younger only are paid an administration fee, and zero ingredient cost. An error was discovered where claims for recipients 19 years old also did not receive the ingredient cost, when it should have been paid. This issue was corrected on May 23, 2014. The affected claims have been reprocessed and pharmacies will receive reimbursement for the ingredient cost on these claims. The adjudication of the reprocessed claims appears on remittance advices dated October 24, 2014.
