

Available Courses for ILT

Eight instructor led (ILT) courses have been created based on the below broad provider types:

- Physician
- Long Term Care
- Behavioral Health
- Medical Outpatient
- Waivers
- Pharmacy
- Dental
- Hospitals

These eight courses are listed in the Course Catalog on our <u>LMS website</u>. Providers will navigate to the correct course for the audience and self-enroll. At that time, he or she will select the preferred date and time to attend training. All details about the content and location of the training will be included in the course description.


Self-Enrollment for ILT

Provider attendees will access the LMS site from a link on the Modernization page at www.medicaid.nv.gov. To open the webpage, the user will click on the "Modernization Project" link under "Featured Links" on the left-hand side of each page of the website. Once on the "Modernization Project" page, refer to the "Provider Training Opportunities" section which will include a link to a learning management system (LMS) site to self-enroll for training, instructions on how to register, and training workshop materials.


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Once the link is pressed, the user will be directed to the Nevada Medicaid Training Portal, as shown below.




1. User will click on the Catalog icon, which will take you to the Course Catalog.




2. User will click on the **Course Catalog** to view all available courses.

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
- 3. User will navigate to and select the appropriate course for their training needs and click the link to register or log in.
 - a. In this example Course seen is training for providers who currently submit an CMS-1500 or HCFA claim form.




- 4. The user will see a more in depth description of the course.
 - a. If this is the first time accessing the LMS system, the user will need to press the **Register** link and complete the one-time registration form.
 - b. If the user has a username and password, he or she will need to press the **Login** link and enter their **username** and **password**.

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
5. Regardless of whether the user registered or logged in, he or she will be taken to this page where the user will click on the **Enroll** link to enroll in the course selected.



6. User will select the date and time he or she wants to attend training and press the Continue button

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The user is now enrolled successfully and will receive a New Course Enrollment email notification.

Other Courses Available

- Due to providers in remote areas, we will also have eight courses created to be delivered via webinar to remove the need to travel to Reno or Las Vegas for instructor led training.
 - The process to self-enroll in a webinar is the same as enrolling in an ILT
- To help with retention of information learned in instructor led or webinar training, the eight courses will be converted to computer based training (CBT) sessions
 - This will happen close to go-live
 - Look for a web announcement broadcasting their availability
 - The process to self-enroll is similar to the one outlined in this document. The only difference is that the user does not need to select a session.

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
