## ICD-10 Diagnosis Code Reference for Drug Claims

Nevada Medicaid/Nevada Check Up allow some Point of Sale drug claims to bypass prior authorization (PA) requirements when submitted with the correct ICD-10 diagnosis on the prescription and the code is transmitted on the claim. Below is a sample list of products. Please refer to the Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 1200, the Nevada Medicaid Preferred Drug List and the Nevada Medicaid Pharmacy Billing Manual for a complete list.

**Anticonvulsants** – bypass PA requirements for children if submitted with seizure disorder diagnoses or the prescriber’s specialty is listed as neurology.

**Aripiprazole (Abilify®)** – bypass PA requirements for children if submitted with diagnosis for autistic disorder.

**Diabetic Supplies** – bypass PA requirement if diabetes diagnosis submitted.

**ADHD/ADD Medications** – bypass PA requirements for children 5 through 17 years of age, if an ADD/ADHD diagnosis is submitted and the prescriber specialty is listed as psychiatry.

**Oral Anticoagulants** (apixaban (Eliquis®), dabigatran (Pradaxa®), edoxaban (Savaysa®) and rivaroxaban (Xarelto®)) – bypass PA requirements if submitted with diagnosis for an FDA-approved indication for the respective medication.

**Duloxetine (Cymbalta®)** – bypass PA requirements if submitted with diagnosis of diabetes with neurological manifestations, or myalgia and myositis.

**Milnacipran (Savella®)** – bypass PA requirements if submitted with diagnosis of fibromyalgia.

**Modafinil (Provigil®)** – bypass PA requirements if submitted with a diagnosis of narcolepsy.

**Oxycodone w/acetaminophen CR Tab (Xartemis XR®)** – bypass PA requirements if submitted with diagnosis of acute pain.
