COVID-19 Billing Guides Updated

Nevada Medicaid has updated the COVID-19 General Billing Guide, the COVID-19 Community-Based Testing & Vaccination Billing Guide, and the Provider Type 22 Dentist: COVID-19 Vaccination Administration Claim Reimbursement Guide with all allowable covered services for COVID-19. Updates include the following for their respective billing guides:

- Addition of contact information, service limitations and claim submissions for Molina Healthcare of Nevada.
- Updates to the names of Evaluation and Management (E/M) Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes.
- Addition of E/M CPT codes 99383 – 99397 for preventative medicine.
- Addition of CPT code 99401 for Stand Alone COVID-19 Vaccine Counseling for children under the age of 21 years old.
- Addition of provider type (PT) 17 specialty 182 – Indian Health Services, Non-Tribal, to the list of allowable PTs that can vaccinate.
- Addition of CPT/Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes for COVID-19 vaccines and administration. This includes: 0004A, 0034A, 91305, 0051A, 0052A, 0053A, 0054A, 91306, 0064A, 91307, 0071A, 0072A, 0073A.
- Addition of Pharmacy claim guidance for COVID-19 vaccines and in-home administration.
- Addition of monoclonal antibody infusion HCPCS codes. This includes: Q0220, M0220, M0221, Q0222, M0222, M0223, M0241, Q0244, M0244, M0246, Q0247, M0247, M0248, J0248, 96365, 96366.
- Guidance on submitting claims for oral treatments.

For any CPT/HCPCS codes that are listed above but have not yet been implemented in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS), claims will be suspended and then reprocessed once implemented.
