COVID-19 Billing Guides Updated

Nevada Medicaid has updated the COVID-19 General Billing Guide, the COVID-19 Community-Based Testing & Vaccination Billing Guide, and the Provider Type 22 Dentist: COVID-19 Vaccination Administration Claim Reimbursement Guide with the following information:

- Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) will no longer accept claims due to lack of sufficient funds. For more information on this program, please visit www.hrsa.gov/coviduninsuredclaim.
- Vaccine administration Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code 0074A (4th dose) for Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 pediatric vaccine is effective for Emergency Use Authorization as of May 17, 2022.
- Vaccine CPT code 91309 and corresponding vaccine administration CPT code 0094A (Booster) for Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, 50 MCG/0.5ML booster, is effective for Emergency Use Authorization as of March 29, 2022.
- Monoclonal Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code Q0221 for Tixagev and Cilgav 600mg, is effective for Emergency Use Authorization as of February 24, 2022.
- The following monoclonal HCPCS codes have been end dated on April 5, 2022, by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration until further notice: Q0247, M0247, M0248.

For any CPT/HCPCS codes that are listed above but have not yet been implemented in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS), claims will be suspended and then reprocessed once implemented.
