## **COVID-19 General Billing Guide Updated**

Nevada Medicaid has updated the COVID-19 General Billing Guide with the following information:

- Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code 99401 with CR modifier, preventive medicine counseling, approximately 15 minutes, for COVID-19 standalone counseling. This code will only be allowed from 12/2/2021 to 5/10/2022. From 5/11/2022 forward, please utilize G3014 or G3015 for COVID-19 standalone counseling for children under the age of 21 years old.
- Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes G3014 and G3015, immunization counseling by a physician or other qualified health care professional for COVID-19, ages under 21 years, 5-15 mins time OR 16-30 mins time. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has made these codes effective 5/11/2022 forward.
- CPT code 91309, Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, with administration codes 0091A (1<sup>st</sup> dose), 0092A (2<sup>nd</sup> dose), 0093A (3<sup>rd</sup> dose), has been updated for only ages 6 years through 11 years of age, effective 6/17/2022.
  - Administration code 0094A (Booster) has been updated for only age 18 years and older, effective 3/29/2022.
- CPT code 91313, Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent, administration code 0134A (Booster), has been updated to 12 years through 17 years effective 10/12/2022, and 18 years and older effective 8/31/2022.
- The following CPT codes have been added for COVID-19 vaccines:
  - 91304, Novavax COVID-19 Vaccine, Adjuvanted, administration code 0044A (Booster), aged 18 years and older, effective 10/19/2022.
  - 91314, Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent, administration code 0144A (Booster), aged 6 years through 11 years, effective 10/12/2022.
  - 91315, Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent, administration code 0154A (Booster), aged 5 years through 11 years, effective 10/12/2022.

For any CPT/HCPCS codes that are listed above but have not yet been implemented in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS), claims will be suspended and then reprocessed once implemented.
