COVID-19 UNWIND: Eligibility Renewal Timeline Available for Recipients

The Continuous Enrollment Condition ends effective March 31, 2023, under the Consolidated Appropriation Act 2023 (CAA). Eligibility renewal packets will be mailed to recipients beginning April 1, 2023. The <u>attached Renewal Timeline</u> specifies each step Nevada will follow during the COVID-19 unwinding period of April 2023 to May 2024.

In an effort to keep recipients/members insured, please encourage Nevada Medicaid recipients to complete and return their eligibility packets promptly.

Recipients may sign up to receive renewal information electronically by creating an Access Nevada Account at accessnevada.dwss.nv.gov.

Please remind Nevada Medicaid recipients to update their contact information to ensure they receive important notices in the mail. Please print and post this flyer in public places and distribute through your social networks.

END OF THE CONTINOUS ENROLLMENT CONDITION RENEWAL TIMELINE

The <u>Continuous Enrollment Condition</u> ends effective March 31, 2023 under the Consolidated Appropriation Act 2023 (CAA). Nevada will begin initiating unwinding-related renewals the month after the end of the Continuous Enrollment Condition. This means that renewals will be initiated April 1, 2023, for individuals with a May 31, 2023 renewal date for June (renewal month) eligibility.

The following timeline and process applies to each month within the unwinding period: April 2023 to May 2024.

MARCH 15, 2023

Ex-parte is executed approximately 15 days before the renewal packets are sent by mail.



Approved ex-parte renewal notices and paper renewal packets are mailed the first of each month, including any unsuccessful ex-parte, with a submission due date of the 31st of the following month.

APRIL 1, 2023





MAY 15, 2023



If the paper renewal packet is not received by the 15 of the month, a Notice of Decision (NOD) is sent automatically advising that eligibility will end if no contact or renewal packet is received.

The 31st is the final day of eligibility for unresponsiveness. Renewal packets received by the 31st are processed and evaluated for

MAY 31, 2023



JUNE 1, 2023 RENEWAL MONTH



If the beneficiary failed to return the renewal packet and is determined ineligible for Medicaid, starting on the first of the month they will have 90 days to submit the completed renewal packet to be re-evaluated.
