Nevada Medicaid Mail to Providers No Longer Forwarded

Effective immediately, Nevada Medicaid has requested the United States Postal Service to no longer forward mail to a new provider address. Instead, it has been requested that the mail be returned to the sender (Nevada Medicaid or First Health Services). When mail is returned, the provider's Medicaid enrollment may be terminated in accordance with Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 100, Sections 103.3A.2 and 106.2.

To ensure that your current address information is on file and your enrollment continues, please contact the Provider Enrollment Unit at First Health Services to validate your information. Call (877) 638-3472 (select the option for "Provider Enrollment").

In accordance with MSM Chapter 100, Section 103.3, providers are required to report in writing within five (5) working days any change in ownership, address, addition or removal of a practitioner or any other information pertinent to the receipt of Medicaid funds. Failure to report these changes may result in the termination of the Medicaid contract at the time of discovery.
