## **COVID-19 UNWIND: End of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Impacts Provider Enrollment Flexibilities**

The COVID-19 public health emergency will expire at the end of the day on May 11, 2023; therefore, all provider enrollment flexibilities granted under the Social Security Act Section 1135 emergency waivers will terminate.

Nevada Medicaid will resume with enrollment screening requirements under Section 102.2 Conditions of Participation-All Providers and Applications of the Medicaid Services Manual, Chapter 100 for new applicants and providers. Additionally, Nevada Medicaid will begin conducting announced or unannounced site visits and Fingerprint-Based Background Checks (FCBC) for Moderate and High-Risk providers who were enrolled under the 1135 emergency waiver during the public health emergency.
