Availability of the "Revalidate Provider" Link to Start Revalidation Application

A revalidation application should only be submitted up to one year prior to a provider's revalidation due date. Effective June 20, 2023, the Provider Web Portal will only display a "Revalidate Provider" link on the Provider Locations page if the provider's revalidation due date is within one year of their current login date. If a provider previously submitted a revalidation application and their revalidation due date is more than a year in advance, they will no longer be able to access that revalidation application. A new revalidation application will need to be started once they are within a year of their revalidation due date.

In the following example that shows the "Action" column on the Provider Locations page, the first provider's revalidation due date is over a year from the current login date. The second provider has a revalidation due date within the year, as indicated by the availability of the "Revalidate Provider" link.
