

## July 24, 2023 Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3131

## Attention Provider Type 13 (Psychiatric Hospital, Inpatient):

## 1115 Institution for Mental Disease (IMD) Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Demonstration Waiver

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has granted Nevada Medicaid the approval to implement the 1115 Institution for Mental Disease (IMD) Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Demonstration Waiver.

The purpose of the Waiver implementation is to waive the current IMD rule, which bars the use of federal Medicaid funds to finance services for individuals ages 22 to 64 residing in "institutions for mental diseases" or IMDs. IMDs are hospitals, nursing homes or other institutions with more than 16 beds that are primarily engaged in providing diagnosis, treatment or care of persons with mental diseases other than dementia or intellectual disabilities.

This Waiver implementation impacts provider type (PT) 13 (Psychiatric Hospital, Inpatient). Detoxification revenue codes applicable to the Waiver that are billed by PT 13 are listed below. These codes were previously billable by PT 13 with age restrictions, but effective August 1, 2023, PT 13 may also bill the codes for individuals ages 22-64 within an IMD.

PT 13 is instructed to split bill if a revenue code in the group below is billed with a revenue code not included in the group below. If a claim with a revenue code not in the group below is not split billed (i.e., billed on a separate claim), the entire claim will deny with error code 2030 (Psychiatric hospital inpatient age restriction).

Revenue Code	Revenue Code Description
0116	Room & Board, private, detoxification
0126	Room & Board, semi-private (two beds), detoxification
0136	Room & Board, semi-private (three or four beds), detoxification
0146	Room & Board, private (deluxe), detoxification
0156	Room & Board, ward, detoxification
