The monovalent Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are excluded from coverage

The FDA announced on April 18, 2023 that the monovalent Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are no longer authorized for use in the United States. Nevada Medicaid has excluded these products from pharmacy coverage.

The Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech bivalent vaccines remain covered and should be used for all doses administered to individuals 6 months of age and older per FDA eligibility guidelines.
