## **Medicaid Centralized Credentialing Effective February 28, 2025!**

Nevada Medicaid Centralized Credentialing was implemented on February 28, 2025. Credentialing establishes that healthcare providers have the qualifications to render services based on licensure, certification, work history and other relevant elements.

- Centralizing the credentialing process will mean a single Credentialing Verification Organization (CVO) will conduct primary source verification, streamlining the process and aligning outcomes.
