Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3610

Attention All Providers: Clinical Records Procurement for Encounter Data Validation

The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy's (DHCFP) External Quality Review Organization (EQRO), Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG), is conducting the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Encounter Data Validation Study. As part of the study, Managed Care Entities (MCEs) are required to provide clinical records documentation for a specified sample of Medicaid recipients.

This study is a required activity. The DHCFP asks that all providers comply with the requests received from the MCEs within the time frames specified. Providers are required to promptly furnish the requested records at no cost, as is required in the Provider Participation Agreement signed with DHCFP.
