Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3642

Attention Provider Types 14 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment), 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment), or 93 (Substance Use Treatment):

Update Regarding Procedure Code 99408

Effective for claims with dates of service on or after July 1, 2024, procedure code 99408 (Alcohol and/or substance abuse screening with brief intervention (15-30 minutes)) has been updated to be payable to the following provider types (PT) and specialties:

- 14 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment)
 - Specialty 300 (Qualified Mental Health Professional)
 - Specialty 305 (Licensed Clinical Social Worker)
 - Specialty 306 (Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist)
 - Specialty 307 (Clinical Professional Counselor)
- 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment)
 - Specialty 300 (Qualified Mental Health Professional)
- 93 (Substance Use Treatment)
 - Specialty 701 (Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor)
 - Specialty 702 (Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor)
 - Specialty 703 (Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor Intern)
 - Specialty 705 (Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Durg Counselor Intern)
 - Specialty 709 (Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor)

Claims with dates of service on or after July 1, 2024, submitted by the above PTs for procedure code 99408 that denied with error code 4801 (No billing rule for procedure) or 4150 (Perf/Facility PT/PS restriction proc billing rule) will be reprocessed automatically to adjudicate correctly.

Results of the reprocessed claims will appear on a future remittance advice. When claims are reprocessed, please be aware that all system and clinical claim editor edits are applicable. As a result, there may be no additional payment, and other claim denials may be received. Providers have the right to appeal denied claims, including those denied upon reprocessing.
