<u>Attention Individual Provider Types 14 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment), 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment), 85 (Applied Behavior Analysis), 93 (Substance Use Treatment):</u>

Supervision Information No Longer Required for Enrollment

Effective August 5, 2025, the following individual provider types are no longer required to disclose agency supervisor information or include the supervisor's licensure when submitting enrollment applications to Nevada Medicaid. This change applies to all enrollment submission types, including initial applications, revalidations, reenrollments, and change/updates. Supervisors will no longer be required to sign DocuSign envelopes for individual enrollment applications.
