Each year, Nevada Medicaid surveys groups of our providers to get feedback on the rates Medicaid pays for services. This input is critical for our budget and policy update process. **Fewer than 6 percent of providers respond.** To increase participation and the quality of data, we would like to know the challenges you face in completing Quadrennial Rate Reviews. Providers should calculate the complete cost **per code, per encounter**. This can include overhead such as facility, utilities, rent, etc. It can also include direct costs such as wages, vendors, supplies, etc. For questions regarding calculating cost per code, contact your Certified Public Accountant.
