

Updates made to filling requirements for Long-acting inhalers, effective 1/5/2026

Effective January 5, 2026, Long-acting inhalers will be included in the Maintenance Medication drug categories and are required to be filled in three-month (84-100 day) supplies. A one-time initial fill of less than three months will be allowed for the first fill to assure tolerability and compliance.
