Medicaid Services Manual Chapters Updated

The following Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) chapters have been updated and posted on the Nevada Health Authority (NVHA) website:

- MSM Chapter 400 – Mental Health Services (effective January 1, 2026)

Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 400 – Mental Health Services were implemented to align with legislative requirements for Assembly Bill (AB) 514, Rehabilitative Residential Mental Health Care (RRMHC) which was passed in the 83rd (2025) Legislative Session. This legislation requires the Nevada Health Authority (NVHA), Division of Nevada Medicaid (DNM) to ensure RRMHC services are covered and reimbursable services under Medicaid for providers with proper licensure and accreditation.

- MSM Chapter 1900 – Transportation Services (effective January 1, 2026)

Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 1900 – Transportation Services were implemented to align updated names for the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) to Nevada Medicaid and references from Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) to Division of Social Services (DSS) to align policy to Senate Bill (SB) 494. Nevada Check Up (NCU) recipients were added as an eligible population for Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) services; added reference to Managed Care Organization (MCO) responsibility of NEMT services for their rural Medicaid and NCU members.
