Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3849

**Attention Provider Type 29 (Home Health Agency and Private Duty Nursing Services):**

**Clarification of Web Announcement 3795**

This Web Announcement serves as follow-up clarification to [Web Announcement 3795](#). The previous announcement inaccurately stated that providers must terminate Private Duty Nursing (PDN) services when a recipient is hospitalized for 24 hours or longer.

Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 900, Section 903.1B(15) does not require termination of services due to hospitalization. Providers may terminate services at their discretion, if appropriate.

If services are expected to resume within the same authorization period, providers may suspend services instead of terminating the case or closing the authorization. Providers must not bill for dates when the recipient is hospitalized and not receiving PDN services.
