**Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3877**

## **Attention Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) Providers: Updates Regarding EVV Claims Submissions**

Attention Personal Care Services (PCS) and Home Health Care providers: Nevada Medicaid and its fiscal agent, Gainwell Technologies, have an important update regarding upcoming changes to the Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) billing process.

Effective April 1, 2026, EVV claims will no longer be routed through Optum and will be replaced with direct submission to the respective payers. Payers will be assigned new claim payer IDs. Claims submitted directly to payers will no longer be visible through Optum and your Connect Center; prior claims will continue to be visible.

### **Action Required:**

#### **State EVV Sandata Users:**

If you are using the Sandata EVV sponsored tool, Sandata will make the required changes on your behalf and route your claims appropriately so there is no further action required to submit claims. To receive 835 files, please ensure you have authorized Sandata to receive this transaction on your behalf. ***Alternate EVV System Users:***

If you are using an Alternate EVV vendor (3<sup>rd</sup> Party Vendor), you must work in conjunction with your billing vendor to update your billing workflows with the appropriate new Payer IDs.
