## **Medicaid Operations Manual Chapters Updated**

The following Medicaid Operations Manual (MOM) chapters have been updated and posted on the Nevada Medicaid website:

- MOM Chapter 1100 – Long Term Provider Tax (effective May 1, 2026)

Nevada Medicaid has adopted revisions to Medicaid Operations Manual (MOM) Chapter 1100, Long Term Provider Tax.

The adopted changes include updating the agency name change from the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) to the new agency name of Nevada Medicaid. Language for failure to pay or late payment of fee has been updated. Language for failure to submit a complete monthly report has been added to include a fine.

- MOM Chapter 1300 – Private Hospital Tax Program (effective May 1, 2026)

Nevada Medicaid has adopted revisions Medicaid Operations Manual (MOM) Chapter 1300 – Private Hospital Tax Program.

The adopted changes include updating the agency name change from the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) to the new agency name of Nevada Medicaid and update Section 1306 – Penalties for Nonpayment to add Subsection C. Nevada Medicaid may waive penalties on a private hospital for failure to pay the full assessment if that hospital requests a payment plan prior to the assessment due date. In order for Nevada Medicaid to waive any penalties, the private hospital must submit a formal request with specific circumstances enumerated to Nevada Medicaid for evaluation. Nevada Medicaid has sole authority to determine if there is good cause to waive the penalties given the specific circumstances enumerated by the request private hospital and that decision may not be appealed. Any payment plan may not negatively affect either the state's budget nor the viability of the private hospital assessment program.
