Hospital Presumptive Eligibility Portal – Addition of Aid Code “AO” for Aged Out of Foster Care Youth, effective June 26, 2026

Effective June 26, 2026, the Presumptive Eligibility (PE) Portal will include a new aid code option for the Aged Out of Foster Care Youth. The aid code “AO” will be an option to choose from the drop-down menu when answering the “Presumptive Eligibility Aid Code” question. This update applies only to providers who determine Hospital Presumptive Eligibility.

The AO aid code is being added to properly identify Aged Out of Foster Care Youth, defined as individuals who meet all the following criteria:

- Under age 26,
- Were in foster care in Nevada or another state and were under the responsibility of the state or a tribal entity at the time they turned 18, and
- Were enrolled in Medicaid while in foster care.

Note: No income or resource evaluation is applied when assessing eligibility for this aid code.
