Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3973

Attention Provider Type 63 (Psychiatric Residential Treatment Services): Updated Enrollment Requirements

Effective July 28, 2026, Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 100 has been updated to add Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF) to the high-risk category. As such, provider type (PT) 63 providers should be aware of the following changes to the provider enrollment process:

All high-risk providers are subject to Fingerprint-Based Criminal Background Checks (FBCB) and site visits as conditions of participation. PT 63 providers will be required to upload a completed and signed [Nevada Department of Public Safety Fingerprint Background Waiver](#) into the “Miscellaneous Attachments” section of their enrollment and revalidation applications.

PT 63 providers will be required to upload a copy of the Medical Director's active license as a board-certified or board-eligible psychiatrist into the “Miscellaneous Attachments” section of the enrollment application.

PT 63 providers will also be required to revalidate every 3 years instead of every 5 years and shall remain high-risk for the duration of the Provider Contract.

Note: As providers were notified in [Web Announcement 3935](#), Nevada Medicaid initiated a “swift revalidation” for Medicaid providers considered to be an elevated risk for vulnerability to fraud, waste, or abuse. PT 63 providers are now required to complete revalidation as a high-risk provider no later than October 31, 2026.
