**Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3996**

**Attention Provider Type 33 (Durable Medical Equipment, Disposable, Prosthetics):**

**Six Month Grace Period for Adoption of the New FA-1B Form**

[Web Announcement 3969](#), which affects multiple forms including the FA-1B, states: *“Effective immediately, providers are requested to use the versions dated 07/13/2026. Beginning August 13, 2026, forms submitted on a previous version will be returned with instructions to resubmit the request using the updated form.”*

Because of the unique nature of the FA-1B form, Nevada Medicaid is extending the transition period for provider type 33 (Durable Medical Equipment (DME), Disposable, Prosthetics) providers. The retired FA-1B form will continue to be accepted until **January 13, 2027, when initiated prior to the 07/13/2026 version update**. Reference to the updated form will continue to be made if a PA requires pending for other reasons.
