Medicaid Operations Manual Chapters Updated

The following Medicaid Operations Manual (MOM) chapters have been updated and posted on the Nevada Medicaid website:

Nevada Medicaid has adopted revisions to Medicaid Operations Manual (MOM) Chapter 200 – Boards, Committees, and Advisory Committees. These revisions were heard and approved through the Public Hearing process pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 422.2369 on **August 25, 2026**, and became effective **August 26, 2026**.

The changes adopted reflect agency names for Nevada Medicaid and the Nevada Health Authority. Definitions have been revised to align with these naming changes. Additional updates have been made to the sections related to the Drug Utilization Review (DUR) Board and the Silver State Scripts Board to ensure consistency with the applicable Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS). Additionally, the Medical Care Advisory Committee (MCAC) has been renamed to the Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC) and revised to reflect current naming conventions and to align with applicable NRS. A section has been added to include the newly implemented Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC) and its corresponding definitions. These updates are intended to enhance clarity, maintain cohesion across all program documents, and support accurate interpretation of policy and operational guidance.

Nevada Medicaid has adopted revisions to Medicaid Operations Manual (MOM) Chapter 1300 – Private Hospital Tax Program. These revisions were heard and approved through the Public Hearing process pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 422.2369 on **August 25, 2026**, and became effective **August 26, 2026**.

The adopted changes include updating hospital meaning to include “and NRS 449.0178” to add Rural Emergency Hospital (REH) as a separate class of private hospitals outpatient services eligible for assessments and state directed payments.
