Nevada Medicaid Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine Policy Effective May 6, 2019

Effective May 6, 2019, Nevada Medicaid will expand the coverage of eligible recipients for the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine to include ages 9 through 45 years based on updated indications from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

For recipients over the age of 18 years, pharmacies will be reimbursed the cost of the medication in addition to a \$7.80 administration fee. For recipients age 18 and younger, only the administration fee is paid.
