Reminder: Nevada Medicaid Reimburses for Laboratory Lead Testing and Essential Laboratory Services

Providers are reminded that laboratory lead testing, and necessary and essential laboratory services, are covered benefits for Nevada Medicaid-eligible recipients. The Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code to bill for lead testing is 83655, which covers venous and capillary blood draws to test for lead levels in the blood.

Lead level assessments are recommended at Well Child exams for children ages 6 months to 6 years. Lead screenings may be included in a Healthy Kids (Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment - EPSDT) visit following the Bright Futures periodicity recommendations.
