## Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Code 87661 (Trichomonas Vaginalis, Amplified Probe Technique) To Be Open for Billing

On January 27, 2020, Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code 87661 (Trichomonas vaginalis, amplified probe technique) will be opened for the provider types listed below to bill effective with dates of service on or after January 1, 2020.

No prior authorization is needed. Do not bill CPT codes 87661 and 87660 (Trichomonas vaginalis, direct probe technique) on the same day.

Any claims for CPT code 87661 with dates of service on or after January 1, 2020, through January 27, 2020, that are submitted and denied will be automatically reprocessed. Providers do not need to resubmit or appeal the denied claims. A future web announcement will notify providers when any impacted claims are reprocessed.
