Attention All Providers: Prior Authorization Requests Denied for Overlapping Services

Nevada Medicaid providers must submit a <u>Prior Authorization Data Correction Form (FA-29)</u> to end services on a prior authorization (PA) if the recipient terminates services or discharges prior to the end date on the PA. If the FA-29 form is not submitted and the recipient seeks treatment elsewhere, the new PA may be denied due to overlapping services and cause delays in the recipient getting the needed services.
