Attention All Providers: Provider Revalidation Deadlines Extended Another 60 Days

Update to <u>Web Announcement 2207</u>: The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) had issued directives to State Medicaid Agencies to help health care providers combat and contain the spread of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One of the directives temporarily waives the provider revalidation requirements. Per this waiver, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) has implemented another 60-day extension for providers to complete revalidations.

Revalidation due dates between July 16, 2020, and September 13, 2020, have been extended 60 days. See the <u>Provider Revalidation Report</u> for your current revalidation due date. The dates in the Report reflect the extension period.

These extensions are for providers' convenience. Providers who do not need to use the additional time may complete their revalidation according to their original revalidation due date.
