## <u>Reminder for Provider Types 29 (Home Health Agency), 39 (Adult Day Health Care) and 55 (Day and Residential Habilitation Services):</u>

## Rate Surveys Due August 24, 2020

Reminder to Web Announcement 2258: During the 2017 Nevada Legislative Session, Assembly Bill 108 (AB 108) was passed. This bill mandates that the State of Nevada Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) conduct a rate review for each provider type enrolled with Nevada Medicaid to determine if the rate of reimbursement accurately reflects the actual cost of providing the service or item.

Provider types 29 (Home Health Agency), 39 (Adult Day Health Care) and 55 (Day and Residential Habilitation Services) can access the surveys online to complete and return to DHCFP. These surveys will request information regarding Current Procedural Terminology (CPT)/Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS)/Revenue Codes billed, the usual and customary charges **providers bill all payers** for those services, and the cost of providing each service/item.

Completed surveys may be returned via US Mail at the address provided on the survey or returned via email to <a href="Rates@DHCFP.nv.gov">Rates@DHCFP.nv.gov</a>. Surveys must be completed and returned by <a href="August 24">August 24</a>, <a href="2020">2020</a>. As providers are valued partners with Nevada Medicaid, DHCFP strongly encourages that all providers enrolled under the provider types listed above complete the survey. Data gathered from provider responses directly contributes to the analysis of current reimbursement rates and may assist in justifying rate adjustments in the future.
