Attention All Providers: Claims that Denied in Error with Timely Filing Error Codes 676 or 677 Have Been Reprocessed

Claims submitted with Third Party Liability (TPL) and Claim Adjustment Reason Code(s) (CARCs) had been denying with timely filing error codes 676 (Date of service exceeds timely filing limit) or 677 (Timely filing limit exceeded) when the recipient file did not reflect TPL. The Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) was updated effective August 17, 2020, to process these claims correctly.

Impacted claims meeting all of the following requirements have been automatically reprocessed to adjudicate correctly:

- Claims were submitted with dates of service on or after August 17, 2018, through August 17, 2020.
- Claims were submitted more than 180 days but less than 365 days from the "To Date of Service"
- Claims had a TPL payment or a TPL denial and Medicaid denied with error codes 676 or 677
- TPL was not on file for the recipient

Results of the reprocessed claims appear on remittance advices dated February 19, 2021. Please note: When claims are reprocessed, please be aware that all system and clinical claim editor edits are applicable. As a result, there may be no additional payment, and other claim denials may be received. Providers have the right to appeal denied claims, including those denied upon reprocessing.
