## Reminder to Bill Intrauterine Devices and Subdermal Implants with a National Drug Code (NDC) with a Unit of 1

Reminder and Update to <u>Web Announcement 699</u>: Intrauterine Devices (IUDs) including but not limited to Kyleena<sup>®</sup>, Liletta<sup>®</sup>, Mirena<sup>®</sup> and Skyla<sup>®</sup> and subdermal implants including but not limited to Nexplanon<sup>®</sup> must be billed with the appropriate National Drug Code (NDC) with a unit of 1, along with the corresponding Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code. If a claim is received with only a HCPCS code for an IUD or subdermal implant, it will be denied, as the claim must also have the appropriate NDC. Claims for IUDs or subdermal implants with NDC units greater than 1 will be denied for exceeding limitations.
