COVID-19 UNWIND: New "Update My Address" Website for Nevada Medicaid Recipients

As the end of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency nears, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is requesting providers distribute an easier way for Nevada Medicaid recipients to update their address: by visiting the following "Update My Address" website - <u>https://dhcfp.nv.gov/UpdateMyAddress</u>

A newly updated flyer is <u>attached</u> for providers to print, post publicly, and distribute. The flyer explains in English and Spanish the multiple ways Nevada Medicaid recipients can update their addresses, including using the new website. Providers and community partners can help spread the word about this new resource using text, social media and email. Resources are posted on the <u>Member Outreach webpage</u> and new social media messages are marked as NEW.

Also, please consider adding the following text to your company email signature for communications with Nevada Medicaid recipients: Medicaid members: Don't miss important notices in the mail to <u>update your address</u> and access your digital Medicaid card by downloading the <u>NV Medicaid App</u>.

Providers will be notified when the expiration of the federal Public Health Emergency has been confirmed by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).
