Medicaid Providers Are Invited to Complete a Survey to Assist Nevada Medicaid in Developing a Centralized Credentialing Process

Centralized Credentialing for Nevada Medicaid is coming soon! Nevada Medicaid is seeking input and experiences from providers to help us understand the benefits of a Credentialing Verification Organization (CVO) that will offer one point of entry for provider credentialing.

Currently, providers are required to apply as many as five (5) times to enroll and credential with each Managed Care Organization (MCO) and/or Dental Benefit Administrator (DBA). Nevada Medicaid wants to alleviate the duration and burden of the credentialing process and is interested in learning directly from providers of their experience. We will use provider feedback to improve upon the process.
