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New Emergency Medicaid Only (EMO) Billing Instructions Published

Emergency Medicaid Only (EMO) provides medical coverage to uninsured individuals who do not qualify for Medicaid due to citizenship/immigration status. This program may pay health care costs for individuals who have experienced a medical emergency, as defined by 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 440.255, Federal Emergency Services (FES) Program.

The new EMO Billing Instructions present an overview of EMO covered and non-covered services, hyperlinks to Nevada Medicaid policy, prior authorization and billing requirements. Additionally, it includes who may be eligible and how to apply for EMO coverage through the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS).
