

COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Fee Increase Effective January 1, 2023

Web Announcement 3104

Effective January 1, 2023, Nevada Fee-for-Service (FFS) Medicaid will reimburse an incentive fee of \$41.69 for covered COVID-19 vaccines billed through pharmacy point-of-sale (POS). This is an increase from the previously allowed incentive fee amount of \$40.11.

Pharmacy providers wishing to receive reimbursement for the updated incentive fee amount on COVID-19 vaccine claims paid after January 1, 2023 onward may reverse and rebill any impacted claims.

Claims for COVID-19 vaccines should be submitted in the following manner:
