## **Attention Provider Types 28 (Pharmacy) and 91 (Pharmacist): Pharmacists Can Now Bill Medicaid and Provide New Services**

Did you know you can bill Nevada Medicaid for more than [40 new procedure codes](#), reach hundreds of thousands of new customers and remove a barrier to accessing birth control and Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) prevention medications? All you need to do is [enroll as Nevada Medicaid provider type \(PT\) 91 – Pharmacist](#).

**Seeing a doctor to get contraception and HIV preventative medications can be a burden for Medicaid recipients/members. Now, recipients can go directly to a pharmacist for those services if the pharmacist is enrolled.**

Attached are two flyers. One flyer is for pharmacies regarding how to enroll and the other flyer is for providers to post publicly so that Medicaid recipients are aware of the service once you enroll.

# Pharmacists Can Now Bill Medicaid & Provide New Services

State of Nevada Medicaid



## Prescriptions Made Easy!

Seeing a doctor to get contraception and HIV preventative medications can be a burden for Medicaid members. Now, they no longer have to. They can come directly to you for some services without a prescription.

During the 81<sup>st</sup> Nevada Legislative Session (2021), Senate Bill (SB) 190 and SB325 passed allowing pharmacist to provide and be reimbursed for services related to self-administered hormonal contraceptives and the prevention acquisition of Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV).

On July 7, 2022, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved Nevada Medicaid's State Plan Amendment to include pharmacist as a new provider type. Since then, Nevada Medicaid has implemented a new provider type (PT) 91 – Pharmacist and established Medicaid policy surrounding pharmacist-provided services.

### COVERED SERVICES:

Nevada Medicaid now reimburses pharmacists for more than 40 codes including the following services without a prescription:

- Ordering certain HIV laboratory testing.
- The dispensing of self-administered hormonal contraceptives.
- The prescribing, dispensing and administration of drugs to prevent the acquisition of HIV.

2. Apply as a Nevada Medicaid PT 91 – Pharmacist at the [Provider Enrollment Portal](#).

# Tired of Getting Prescriptions for Birth Control & PrEP?

## State of Nevada Medicaid



Pharmacists can now dispense some birth control and PrEP for Medicaid members without a prescription.

**ASK YOUR PHARMACIST IF THEY ARE ENROLLED**



### WHAT'S NEW?

During the 81st Nevada Legislative Session (2021), Senate Bill (SB) 190 and SB325 authorized pharmacists to provide and be reimbursed for some services without a prescription. Pharmacists must be enrolled Medicaid providers (PT-91).

### WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION?

Nevada Medicaid covers these services from a pharmacist:

- Self-administered hormonal contraception
- Emergency contraception
- HIV preexposure prophylaxis (PrEP)
- HIV postexposure prophylaxis (PEP)
- Ordering and conducting certain HIV laboratory tests.
