Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3288

Rate Updates Implemented for Home and Community Based Waiver for the Frail Elderly Services

During the 82nd Nevada Legislative Session (2023), Senate Bill (SB) 504 passed requiring rate increases for provider type (PT) 57 (Home and Community Based Waiver for the Frail Elderly in Residential Facilities for Groups) and PT 59 (Home and Community Based Waiver for the Frail Elderly in an Assisted Living Facility). The adjusted rates are effective with dates of service on or after January 1, 2024.

The impacted PT 57 procedure codes are:

- S5126 (Attendant care services; per diem) with modifiers U1, U2, U3 or U4
- T1016 (Case management, each 15 minutes)

The impacted PT 59 procedure code is:

- T2031 (Assisted living; waiver, per diem) with modifiers U1, U2 or U3

Any claims submitted by PTs 57 and 59 for the above procedure codes with dates of service on or after January 1, 2024, through claims processed prior to February 21, 2024, that paid the previous rate will be reprocessed automatically at a later date. Results of any reprocessed claims will be reported on a future remittance advice.

When claims are reprocessed, please be aware that all system and clinical claim editor edits are applicable. As a result, there may be no additional payment, and other claim denials may be received. Providers have the right to appeal denied claims, including those denied upon reprocessing.
